



PAPHOS hosts a beautiful harbour with its scenic fort while the extensive Archaeological Park nearby houses the wonderful mosaics, Odeon and the lighthouse. Another large archaeological site in Paphos is the Tombs of the Kings. In Roman times, Paphos was the capital of Cyprus and the “footprints” of its past have been preserved for posterity.

Approximately 16km east of Paphos, is the world famous Aphrodite’s Rock (Petra Tou Romiou) - a spectacular site where Aphrodite, the goddess of love and beauty, is said to have sprung out of the sea foam.



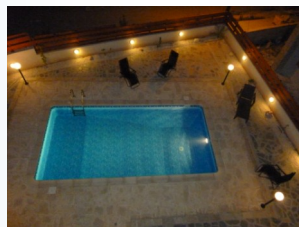

The garden benefits from a good-sized pool and high-quality garden furniture where you can enjoy the peace and quiet of this tranquil neighbourhood.



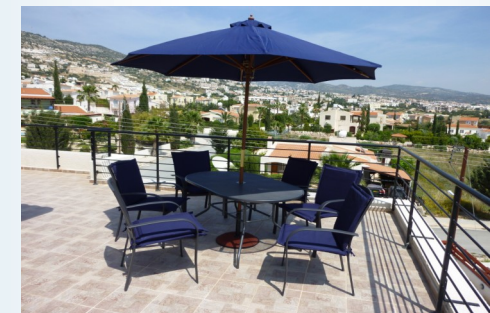
A large, well furnished roof terrace overlooks the surrounding areas. From here you can admire the magnificent view of the sea and mountains.
