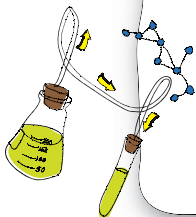
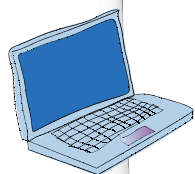
Candidates need to be registered at least one week beforehand. Comprehensive information on the admissions process is available on our website or in our prospectus pack.
